departure. Our courteous and experienced Tour Manager, who will accompany you with the tour, will meet you at Kolkata Airport. He will assist you to complete all the formalities




before boarding your flight to Kuala Lumpur. Upon arrival proceed to international departure for your flight to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

architecture in the city. Its design is inspired by a spaceship and the location is very picturesque as well at the corner of the Persiaran Perdana.

DAY 2 – KUALA LUMPUR – Batu Caves + Genting highlands tour with cable car

- BATU CAVES: Batu Caves, one
 of Kuala Lumpur's most
 frequented tourist attractions,
 is a limestone hill comprising
 three major caves and a number
 of smaller ones. Located



approximately 11 kilometers to the north of Kuala Lumpur, this 100-year-old temple features idols and statues erected inside the main caves and around it. Incorporated with interior

limestone formations said to be around 400 million years old, the temple is considered an important religious landmark by Hindus.

<u>Cathedral Cave</u> – the largest and most popular cavern in Batu
Caves – houses several Hindu shrines beneath its 100-metre-



high arched ceiling. At the foot of Batu Hill are two other cave temples <u>— the Art Gallery Cave and Museum Cave</u> — which houses numerous Hindu statues and paintings.

Genting Skyway which at its opening was the world's fastest and South East Asia's longest gondola lift, and the newer Awana Skyway. Enjoy the breathetaking view with a 10min gondola cable car ride across the Awana SkyWay. The popular theme park and integrated hill



resort represents a popular weekend getaway from the city heat, resort is home to a 4D cinema, a world-class casino, a splash pool and plenty of games and rides, including Southeast Asia's fastest and longest cable car.
