### **ITINERARY**

## DAY1 - HANOI Arrival at Hanoi + Hanoi City tour

- Meet and greet by our representative at the Hanoi airport (2 am) and get transferred to hotel (Early Check in & breakfast)
- Have breakfast at the hotel, rest and proceed for a city tour of Hanoi.
- Visit <u>Ho Chi Minh Complex</u> inclusive of Ba Dinh Square, Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, as well as his private residence from 1954 until 1969. It is a large building located in the center of Ba Dinh Square, where Ho, Chairman of the Workers' Party of Vietnam,

read the Declaration of Independence on 2 September 1945, establishing the Democratic Republic of Vietnam. The wooden ethnic minority style house, which was built on stilts, is surrounded by lovely peaceful gardens. In the same complex you



will see the <u>One Pillar Pagoda</u>, founded by King Ly Thai To in 1049. This structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi.

- Continue visit <u>Tran Quoc Pagoda</u>, locates on a small peninsula on the East side of the dazzling West Lake, this is the most ancient pagoda in Hanoi with its history line of more than 1,500 years.
- We then visit the <u>Temple of</u>
  <u>Literature</u>, Vietnam's first university.
  Constructed in 1070, the gardens and well-preserved architecture offer a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past.
- In the evening, you can enjoy water puppet show (optional)

Stay overnight at Hanoi.

## DAY2 - HALONG BAY- Overnight cruise at Halong Bay

 Have breakfast and check-out from the hotel and transfer to Ha Long Bay. At 9am, journey for 3 hours driving to <u>Halong Bay, the pride of</u> <u>the Gulf of Tonkin, a Natural World</u> <u>Heritage as designated by UNESCO</u>



in 1994 and 2006. The road will pass by the Red River delta with green paddy fields and rural villages, where hard-work farmers are busy with their farming jobs, ploughing buffaloes or planting

seedling.

 08:00 - 08:30am Pick up at Old Quarter area to transfer from Hanoi to Halong Bay 11:30 Arrive at cruise dock, we help you to check in at cruise lounge area 12:15 Transfer to cruise, check in, welcome drinks



13:00 You will have a delicious lunch and enjoy the stunning views when the boat cruises towards the southeast of Halong Bay, passing Fighting- Cock and Finger Islet. 14:45 Visiting

Luon Cave or Pearl Farm area by bamboo boat or kayaking.' 16:00 You are going to Titov Island - where you can go swimming or hiking to the top for another stunning, panoramic view of the Bay 17:30 Back on board, you can enjoy Sunset party with HAPPY HOUR (from 17:30 – 19:00) –



buy 2 get 1 free at bar. 18:30 Cooking Demo class or free time 19:00 Delight in the shimmering atmosphere of thousands of stars while eating a fantastic, expertly prepared dinner. 20:30 This is the perfect time for you to relax with spa treatments or enjoy a cocktail.

# DAY 3 - HALONG - HO CHI MINH - Halong Bay Cruise + Depart from Cruise + Flight to Ho chi minh

You should wake up early to enjoy the dawn on the sea in the early morning.
 06:00 Warm up your day with a Tai
 Chi lesson on the sundeck with a
 breathtaking view as the sun rises on
 Halong Bay. 07:00 Light breakfast is
 served at the restaurant. 08:00 Your



next stop is the magnificent Sung Sot Cave, one of the biggest caves in Ha Long Bay with beautiful stalactites. You will be

surprised by the breathtaking panoramic view across the Bay once you exit the cave as well as the stalactites and stalagmites formed over millions of years which have taken on fascinating shapes. 09:30 Back on board, check-out and return



to Tuan Chau Island 10:00 Brunch is served at the restaurant and payment 10:45 Disembark at Tuan Chau Marina, return to Hanoi. 15h - 15:30 Drop off in hotel /point in Old quarter area

- Later, journey back to Hanoi Airport for flight to Ho chi minh.
- Reach Ho chi minh and get transferred to hotel and stay overnight.

## DAY4- HO CHI MINH - Ho chi Minh city tour + Cu Chi Tunnel

- Have breakfast and check-out from the hotel.
- Proceed for Ho Chi Minh city tour and start with the <u>War Remnants Museum</u>, one of the most famous historical attractions in Saigon. Coming to the War Remnants Museum, you can learn



a part of how Vietnamese had struggled and fought for their

independence, freedom and peace of the nation and the locals' perspective of the Vietnam War. The exhibits, such as weapons, documents and photographs, display in the museum are firm evidence of war crimes in Vietnam that speak for the heroic

actions of the former Vietnamese generation.

- Next, visit the <u>Reunification</u>
   <u>Palace</u>, the witness of the fierce
   Vietnam War that ended in 1975. The grand building today is a Museum and Hall of official receptions.
- Nearby the Palace is <u>Notre Dame Cathedral</u> (view from outside only), built between 1877 and 1883 and colonial-styled Central Saigon Old Post Office, one of the city's major landmarks.
- Emperor Jade Pagoda is a must-visit attraction for its stunning and intricate architecture, featuring elaborate carvings, statues, and altars. As you explore the pagoda, you'll be amazed

by the intricate details and the skillful craftsmanship that went into its construction. It's truly a sight to behold and a testament

to the rich cultural heritage of Vietnam.

 Drive to <u>Cu Chi Tunnels</u> – the network of over 200km of tunnels became legendary when they played a vital role in the War. Cu Chi Tunnels, an incredible underground tunnel

network constructed by Vietnamese resistance fighters during

the long struggle for independence. In their heyday, the tunnels were functioning underground cities including numerous trap doors, specially constructed living areas, storage facilities, weapons factories,




field hospitals, command centers & kitchens. After a short introduction video showing how the tunnels were constructed, you will have a chance to crawl into a short section of the tunnels to feel the oppressive narrowness and heat inside.



• Return to Saigon. Check-in to the hotel and stay overnight.

# DAY5 - RETURN - Mekong River Cruise + Ben Thang Market Shopping + Transfer to airport for return Flight

• Have breakfast at the hotel and journey to My Tho, the homeland of coconut and family factories with local products like coconut candy, rice paper. Upon arrival, embark on the boat <u>cruising on the mighty</u> <u>Mekong River</u> through the canal of



banks. We stop to visit an island in the area, enjoy the fresh tropical fruits served in the heart of the lush garden accompanied by traditional southern Vietnamese folk music. Later, embark on other small boats rowed by the local people through



the small canals shadowed by water coconut trees to visit the local factories. There you will taste the honey tea and see the

local people produce the coconut candy milk and of course you also can try it or stroll in the garden where the locals feed honeybee. Walk to a lane where a horse-drawn cart awaits you to transfer to visit



handicraft village, a coconut candy factory, enjoy tropical fruit, traditional music and then relaxation with rowing boat through

the narrow under shade palm, treelined canals of Mekong River before returning to My Tho by motorized boat.

Late afternoon, visit <u>Ben Thanh</u>
 <u>market</u>, a symbol of Saigon. You can
 indulge in some shopping here.



- Then get transferred to airport for your return flight to Kolkata at Midnight.
