ITINERARY

DAY1 - CEBU - Arrival + Transfer to hotel + Rest

- Assemble at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport
 - three hours prior to the departure. Our courteous and experienced Tour Manager, who will accompany you with the tour, will meet you at Kolkata Airport. He will assist you to complete all the formalities before boarding your flight to Singapore.



Upon arrival proceed to international departure for your flight to Manila.

- Arrive at Cebu. Complete all the immigration formalities and board on to the coach and transfer to your hotel.
- Check in and have lunch.
- Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.



DAY2 - BOHOL - Chocolate hills + Bohol countryside trip + Loboc river cruise

 After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, you get transfered to Bohol by ferry for Bohol Countryside Tour. You will experience several hours of fun and enjoyment visiting Bohol's natural and cultural wonders such as -



• <u>Chocolate Hills</u> (nominated as one of the natural wonders of the world), and one of the most stunning natural attraction in Asia. If there's one thing that Bohol is most famous for, it is these conical,

symmetrical haycock hills. That will turn chocolate brown during dry season.


- Tarsier Sanctuary (home of the world's smallest primate), A known midget monkey in the Philippines. The smallest primate creatures can only be found in Bohol.
- Loboc River (where you can enjoy a scenic river cruise), You will be treated into a one-hour cruise, an hour-long lunch buffet with the great views of the Loboc river. Onboard a motorized covered raft, a sumptuous Bohol-inspired dishes paired with a musician an acoustic performer to

entertain while cruising the river. • **Bohol Python and Wildlife Park** - Bohol Biggest Python in Captivity where you can take pictures.

- Bilar` Man made forest: Be amazed of the mini forest which are thick with a kaleidoscope of green foliage. A suit after tourist attraction in Bhol.
- Baclayon Church This is one of the most precious historical site in Bohol. This Roman Catholic church shows the century old Christianity is evolving in Bohol. Some of the remnants and evidence of Spanish colonialization in the Philippines. (This is an optional part of the itinerary, you may opt not to include this on your tour if you desire)



• **Blood Compact Shrine** (exact spot of the first treaty between the Spaniards and the Filipinos), Bohol has been included in the book of history in the world as one of the former Spanish Colony. As such this province has many historical sites that reflects the events of Spaniards ruling era. And Blood compact shrine is one of the monument that also



nice to witness if you are more inclined about world history. (This is an optional part of the Itinerary, you may opt to exclude this if you desire)

• After the tour get transferred to your hotel have dinner and stay overnight at hotel.

DAY 3 - CEBU - Full day Cebu highland and Cebu historical city tour + Flight to Puerto Princessa at evening

which fully blooms in October.


• <u>Temple Of Leah</u> -- Temple of Leah, dubbed as "Cebu's Taj Mahal," is a grand gesture of love from a husband to his late wife. But unlike the Taj Mahal, which is a mausoleum, Temple of Leah is a shrine

holding the memory and treasures of Leah Albino-Adarna, the late

wife of Teodorico Soriano Adarna.

• Post lunch drive to Cebu and proceed for a Cebu historical city tour.




Head to <u>Fort San Pedro</u>, a military outpost founded in 1565 that now contains a tranquil garden in its inner courtyard. <u>Basilica del Santo Nino</u>, which houses a revered 16th-century statue of the Christ child.
 <u>Magellan's Cross</u>, which was installed by Portuguese and Spanish explorers under orders from Ferdinand Magellan upon

arriving in Cebu in 1521. Pass by <u>Cebu Heritage monument</u>. Your final stop is <u>Casa Gorordo Museum</u>, located in a private home

built in the 1850s for a wealthy family.

Made with Mactan coral stone and pure
Philippine hardwood, the fine house has
been restored and furnished in period style.



 Reach Puerto Princessa, have dinner and check in to the hotel for overnight stay




DAY4 - El Nido — Underground River Tour + Transfer to El Nido

Have breakfast and check out from hotel.
 Then proceed for Underground River Tour.

• A new Seven Wonders of Nature, the <u>UNESCO World Heritage-listed</u>

<u>Puerto Princesa Underground River</u> flows through a limestone cave system before spilling into the South China Sea. A paddle through this eerie

ecosystem, filled with otherworldly cave formations and chattering bats, is one of the Philippines' most unforgettable experiences.you can focus on the scenery of Ulugan Bay and the karst mountains on the journey, instead of worrying about directions and navigation. Once there, take



a guided tour of the underground river, one of the longest navigable underground rivers of the world, while listening to commentary about its history and geology.

Have lunch after the tour and then **board** the coach for transfer to El Nido. One of the most famous destinations in the Philippines are the famed El Nido Islands. This beach paradise is

so famous that no trip to the Philippines would be complete without a visit

It takes around 5 hrs to reach El nido. You can just sit back and relax enjoying the beauty of the Island when the professional driver takes care of everything. You will be transferred in a modern air conditioned car.

Have Lunch in the middle and reach El Nido late afternoon. • Check in to the hotel and relax. Later enjoy the evening at this

beautiful island on your own.

Have dinner at an Indian restaurant and overnight stay at El Nido.

DAY5- EL NIDO - Full day El Nido Island hopping tour

 Have breakfast and go for a <u>Island hopping</u> day tour in El nido with lunch. Discover the clear waters of Miniloc Island, where you can explore three breathtaking lagoons

• Secret Lagoon Beach-The Secret Lagoon is hidden within an island with a pristine white beach and crystal clear water. You go there

to enjoy the view from the beach, the beach itself and to explore

the Secret Lagoon.

Shimizu Island Its white-sand beach is a cool place to get shelter and to hang out because it's filled with lush green trees. Like in most parts of El Nido, you can enjoy swimming in its clear blue water while enjoying an awesome view of the karsts.







- <u>The Seven Commandos Beach's</u> limestone mountain and lush greenery, it is definitely the place to refresh and rejuvenate one's mind, body, and soul.
- <u>The Big lagoon</u> features the full beauty of El Nido's lagoons: rippling clear waters, rock formations around you and under the water, like an idyllic marine waterway
- Enjoy the vibrant nightlife of El nido at evening, have dinner and a memorable stay at your resort.

- The Manila American Cemetery and Memorial dates to World War II and holds the largest number of US soldiers killed in WWII of any cemetery in the world, in addition to soldiers from the Philippines and other Allied nations.

 - Rizal wrote his famous poem 'My Last Farewell' and was executed by the Spanish in 1896.

walled city of Manila. The fort is one of the most important historical sites in Manila.
