


#### **ITINERARY**

## DAY1 - PATTAYA Flight to Bangkok + Transfer to Pattaya + Alcazar Show in evening




 Rest of the day is at leisure; you can explore the city on own and go shopping or opt for below mentioned optional tours at an additional price.




have a fun time admiring the entertaining live band and dance performances by professional artists on board and have dinner on cruise.

kilometers to the north of Kuala Lumpur, this 100-year-old temple features idols and statues erected inside the main caves and around it. Incorporated with interior limestone formations said to be around 400 million years old, the temple is considered an important religious landmark by Hindus.

<u>Cathedral Cave</u> – the largest and most popular cavern in Batu Caves – houses several Hindu shrines beneath its 100-metre-high arched ceiling. At the foot of Batu Hill are two other cave temples <u>– the Art</u> <u>Gallery Cave and Museum Cave</u> – which houses numerous Hindu statues and paintings.



Genting Skyway which at its
 opening was the world's fastest
 and South East Asia's longest
 gondola lift, and the newer Awana
 Skyway. Enjoy the breathetaking
 view with a 10min gondola cable
 car ride across the Awana SkyWay.
 The popular theme park and
