ITINERARY

DAY 1 – DEPART FROM KOLKATA – Overnight Flight

• Assemble at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport three hours prior to the departure. Our courteous and experienced Tour Manager, who will accompany you with the tour, will meet you at Kolkata Airport. He will assist you to complete all the formalities before boarding your flight to Kuala Lumpur.



DAY 2 - YOGJAKARTA – Arrival at Yogjakarta + Merapi Volcano Tour + Check in formalities.

- Upon arrival proceed to international departure for your flight to Yogjakarta.
- Upon your arrival at Adisucipto International Airport in Yogyakarta, complete the immigration formalities
- Drive to Cangkringan village to do Merapi Lava tour with jeep 4x4 to explore the lava-strewn slopes of Mount

<u>Merapi</u>. One of Indonesia's most active volcanoes, Mt. Merapi's name literally means "mountain of red fire." t is one of the world's

most active and dangerous volcanoes. It contains an active lava dome, which regularly produces pyroclastic flows. It has been active for 10,000 years. This fire mountain remains one of the most active and dangerous volcanoes in the world. Snap your own momentous memories over the picturesque spots of the volcano.



- Then get transported to your hotel and check in and rest of the day is free to do your own activities.
- Have dinner at local restaurant and stay overnight in the hotel at Yogjakarta.

DAY 3 - YOGJAKARTA - Full day trip to Borobudur Temple + Prambanan Temple + Ramayana Ballet Show

• After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, you spend a full day exploring the wondrous of Yogjakarta. The tour start at 07.30 to visit Borobudur Temple, **UNESCO World Heritage site**. It takes 1.5 hour drive from Yogyakarta to Magelang City. Borobudur Temple is the largest Buddhist Temple in the world. The temple consists of nine stacked platforms, six square and



three circular, by topped a central dome. It is decorated with 2,672 relief panels originally and 504 Buddha statues. Borobudur Temple Compounds This famous Buddhist temple, dating from the 8th and 9th centuries, is located in central Java. It was built in three tiers: a



pyramidal base with five concentric square terraces, the trunk of a cone with three circular platforms and, at the top, a monumental

stupa. The walls and balustrades are decorated with fine low reliefs, covering a total surface area of 2,500 m2. Around the circular platforms are 72 openwork stupas, each containing a statue of the Buddha. The monument was restored with UNESCO's help in the 1970s.



• Have lunch in local resturant and proceed to witness the <u>Prambanan</u>

<u>Temple. Built in the 10th century, this</u>

<u>is the largest Hindu temple compound</u>

<u>dedicated to Shiva</u> in Indonesia. Rising above the centre of the last of these concentric squares are three temples decorated with reliefs illustrating the



epic of the Ramayana, dedicated to the three great Hindu divinities (Shiva, Vishnu and Brahma) and three temples dedicated to the

animals who serve them. This is a magnificently renovated temple garden, dedicated to kings who once considered themselves as Gods. The centrally located Shiva temple overlooks a series of smaller shrines, spread out over an open-air museum of Hindu-Javanese antiquities. The walls feature marvelous examples of Indian



influenced culture once predominant on Java. This is how the palaces and tabernacles of powerful Buddhist and Hindu kingdoms must have looked like in the 7th and 8th century AD.

evening enjoy a spectacular Ramayana Ballet show. Probably Indonesia's most spectacular live performance, the Ramayana Ballet at Prambanan takes place at an open-air theater or on an indoor stage near the temples Prambanan outside Yogyakarta. A cast of over 200 musicians dancers and perform



episodes from the Hindu Ramayana epic with a traditional gamelan gong-and-drum orchestra.

• Enjoy a sumptuous dinner and stay overnight at Yogjakarta

DAY 4 - YOGJAKARTA - BALI - Arrival in Bali +Check in & rest

- After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and transfer to Yogjakarta airport for departure to Bali.
 - Arrive at Bali Airport where the representative will greet you and transfer you to your pre-booked hotel. On your way to the hotel, witness the amazing scenery this island has to offer.



• Reach the hotel and proceed with the check-in formalities and rest for the day.

DAY 5- BALI - Kintamani Volcano + Luwak Coffee plantation + Penglipuran village + Ubud handicraft village + Tegelang rice field + Tegenungan waterfalls + Bali swing

- Wake up in the morning, have a delicious breakfast at the hotel.
- Get ready and start off the day by visiting the Kintamani Village famous for its Mount Batur viewing point, the latter one is an active volcano. Sip a cup of coffee while taking in the stunning views of Mt.Batur and Lake Batur.



- Drive to the coffee plantations to understand the process of one of the <u>costliest coffee in the world</u> -<u>the Luwak coffee.</u>
- Later, experience a whole new world from the rest of Bali as you enter the *Penglipuran Village which is a traditional countryside village* owning a unique lifestyle, architecture as well as culture. Take a walk through this sparkling clean and unspoiled landscape of the village and witness its culture and



the classic Balinese houses made of bamboo and stone with beautifully built entrances. The villagers here also host some fun activities for tourists related to their daily lifestyle like cooking and making their traditional handicrafts.

After having lunch, drive to see the serene landscapes of <u>Bali - the</u>
 <u>Tegalalang Rice Terraces</u>, where the far stretched land is also covered with paddy fields that appear straight out of a postcard.



• Next visit the scenic <u>Tegenungan waterfalls</u> and spend some time in *Ubud's arts and handicrafts market*.

- Spend a perfect evening, just like your childhood days as you embark on the *iconic Bali Swing* overlooking the beautiful countryside rice terraces of Bali.
- Return back to the hotel/resort/villa for an overnight stay at kuta,



DAY 6 - BALI – Taman Ayun temple + Handara Gate + Ulundunu temple + Twin Lakes + Wangiri hidden hills + Tanha lot Temple complex

• Wake up in the morning and have a delicious breakfast at the hotel.

• Start off your day by visiting one of the most sacred and biggest temple of bali, Taman Ayun temple.

- Next visit the most Instagrammable places in Bali - <u>The Handara Gate</u>, where you can get yourself clicked between the artistic Balinese Gate to upgrade your Insta feed.
- Just a 5 minute drive south will take you to one of the most picturesque temples of Bali *Ulun Danu Temple* which is situated on the shores of Lake Bratan and is dedicated to Lord Shiva and Maa Parvati.
- Later drive to picturesque <u>Twin lakes</u> and <u>Wangiri hidden hills</u>.

- In the evening, head to one of the most iconic offshore temples of Bali the *Tanah lot temple*, *an ancient Hindu temple* perched on top of a large rock in the sea. Spend a lovely evening watching a beautiful sunset over the Arabian Sea.
- Return to the hotel/ villa/ resort for an overnight stay in Kuta.



DAY 7 - NUSA PENIDA - Full day Nusa Penida Island Tour

- Wake up in the morning, have a hearty breakfast in the hotel, and get ready for the most exciting day in Bali.
- Get ready and board your transfer to the Sanur Harbor, from where you will be taking a boat to reach the <u>Nusa</u> <u>Penida island.</u>
- Start your Nusa Penida tour by hiking through a precarious and narrow trail down a mountain onto the shoreline to reach the famous <u>Kelingking Beach</u>.
- Next, visit the <u>Angel's Billabong</u> which is a beautiful natural rock pool that opens straight to the ocean and can be accessed easily by climbing
- Just close to the Angel's Billabong is the <u>Broken Bay</u> which is actually a large rock archway from where you can marvel at the ocean as it flows in and out of a natural bowl surrounded by towering cliffs

down a few steps.

• In the afternoon, take a stopover for lunch and treat your taste buds to the traditional Balinese cuisine.



- Conclude your day excursion of Nusa Penida by <u>snorkeling in the crystal</u> <u>clear blue waters</u> to discover the majestic marine life of the region.
- Later, board your boat back to the main island of Bali.
- Return back to the hotel/resort/villa for an overnight stay in Kuta.



DAY 8 - BALI - Tenjong benoa water sports + Afternoon visit to Uluwatu Temple + Kekak Fire Dance + Jimbaran Bay Sea Food Dinner.

 Wake up in the morning and have a delicious breakfast at the hotel.

• Then visit <u>Tanjung Benoa beach</u> in Nusa Dua. Tanjung Benoa is famous for water sports activities & offers a huge variety of watersports, from jet ski, para sailing, snorkeling, scuba diving, seawalker, fly board and your choice of water based

activities is limitless. Enjoy one round of parasailing, Banan boat and Jet Ski.

<u>Padang Beach</u>

 In the afternoon, head out to explore one of the most beautiful temples in south Bali - the <u>Uluwatu</u> <u>temple</u> which is located on a massive cliff on an edge of the Indian Ocean.



- Feel the tiredness wear out as you watch a beautiful sunset, leaving its beautiful shades over the waters and the sky around.
- Later, get ready for Bali's most iconic art performance - the <u>Kecak Fire</u> <u>Dance show</u> which takes place at a clifftop amphitheatre beside Uluwatu



Temple.The Kecak Fire Dance show starts at sunset, usually around 6 pm depicting the iconic tale of Ramayana in an artistic

form by the dancers and ends when fire torches in the stage's centre flicker against the darkened sky and the echoing chants subside.

- Proceed direct to <u>Jimbaran Bay for</u> <u>dinner served with SEAFOOD BBO</u> <u>dinner</u>
- Return back to the hotel and spend night in Kuta.



DAY 9 - RETURN – Transfer to airport + Arrival at Kolkata

- Early morning after breakfast, drop to Denpasar airport for your return flight to kolkata.
- Arrive at Kolkata and complete all the immigration formalities before leaving the airport. Bid goodbye to all the friends you have met during the tour. We will look forward for your next trip with us.
